

ORDINANCE REGARDING JUSTICES OF THE PEACE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Plainville, in meeting duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1.

a. The number of Justices of the Peace to be elected in the town of Plainville on November 5, 1996 and quadrennially thereafter shall be thirty (30).

b. Each major party, as defined in Section 9-372 (5)B of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, shall be entitled to nominate ten (10) candidates for Justice of the Peace.

c. When there is a political party which is a major party as defined in Section 9-372(5)A of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, but is not a major party as defined in said Section 9-372(5)B, said party shall be entitled to nominate six (6) candidates for Justice of the Peace.

d. Electors who are not members of major parties as defined in Section 9-372(5) of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, shall be appointed as Justices of the Peace in accordance with the provisions of Section 9-184c of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended.

SECTION 2. The Ordinance entitled "Justice of the Peace Ordinance," adopted by the Town Council on July 20, 1964, is hereby repealed upon the effective date of this Ordinance, which shall be thirty (30) days following passage and publication.
