Plainville's Public Influenza Clinic Info

TO: Eligible Plainville residents

On October 25th, 2010 from 12noon - 3pm at Our Lady of Mercy Parish Gymnasium, 19 South Canal St., this season's influenza vaccination will be administered by intramuscular injection and offered, at no cost, to those who meet at least one (1) of the following eligibility qualifications:

- **Plainville residents 6 months of age and older.**
- **Any municipal employee.**
- **All children aged 6 months – 8 years of age whose influenza vaccination status is either unknown; never received seasonal influenza vaccine before; or who received only 1 dose of seasonal vaccine in their first year of vaccination, should receive 2 doses of a 2010–11 seasonal influenza vaccine (separated by min 4 weeks).**
- **All children aged 6 months – 8 years of age who did not receive at least 1 dose of an influenza A (H1N1) 2009 vaccine, regardless of previous influenza vaccine history, should also receive 2 doses of a 2010–11 seasonal influenza vaccine (separated by min 4 weeks).**

***** Proof of Plainville residency or Municipal employment may be required.**
