Qualifying applicants must have a Bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice or related field. (Master's degree and FBI Academy training preferred). Ideal candidate will have at least 10 years law enforcement experience in increasingly responsible positions; supervisory, management, leadership, and written & oral communications skills; proven, thorough knowledge and application of modern police management & operations practices; knowledge & experience in community-oriented policing; ability to have or obtain a State of Connecticut Police Officer Standards and Training Certification as "police officer" and valid Connecticut driver's license. Final candidate will be subject to background investigation, drug screen, physical examination, and psychological testing.

The Plainville Police Department has 35 sworn officers and 7 civilian staff. The Chief manages a budget of \$3 million.
