Also present were Council members Vice Chairman Wazorko, Saunders, Szach, Ciotto, Rupaka, Town Manager Lee and Town Clerk Skultety. Councilwoman Toffey was absent.

Councilman Hurley led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Police Chief Catania thanked the Town Council for their support and commended the entire Town for their efforts during the aftermath of Snow Storm Alfred.

Chief Catania went on to say that a recent process for the police promotion for the rank of Sergeant consisted of two components; a written examination and an oral exam. The process was designed to test for both technical and practical knowledge for the determination as to who might have the skills to be trained to be an excellent police supervisor for the Town of Plainville.

Police Chief Catania continued with the test results and made the recommendation of appointing Officer Clifford J Roper and Officer Nicholas Mullins, the two top candidates as Sergeants.

Councilman Saunders motioned to promote Officer Clifford J. Roper and Officer Nicholas as Police Sergeants effective November 3, 2011. The motion was seconded by Councilman Ciotto and passed 6-0.

The Sergeants were then presented their badges by Councilman Saunders and were subsequently pinned on by their wives.

Chairman Hurley and the Town Council congratulated the Sergeants and wished them well.

Councilman Saunders motioned to adjourn at 6:20pm. The motion was seconded by Councilman Rupaka and passed 6-0.
