Manafort is working on the demolition and putting the sight back together. Mr. Lozaw asked if there is discussion regarding the 'dip' or Alternate C on the project. There has been discussion with the contractor and Mr. Lee but no decision has been made. They are in the process of assessing the cost for it and will bring it to the Town and Building Committee for a decision. Discussion continued.

Request for Qualifications and Proposals – Construction Management Services:

Chairman Belanger informed the committee that several weeks ago a meeting was held and the decision was made to hire a Construction Management At-Risk Firm for the Wheeler School, Middle School of Plainville and the Plainville High School projects. The bid statement was sent out and Construction Management Service packets are expected to be returned to the Town of Plainville by 12:00 noon on April 22, 2016. At the next meeting on Monday, April 25 the CPBC will review the bids and select 3 or 4 companies to interview. The committee will also look at the original lists of things that need to be done at the three sites and make sure it is complete

prior to meeting with the companies to review the scope of work. The list will be finalized and presented to the Town Council to request a referendum in September. There will be a Special Meeting on Thursday, April 28 at 5:00 pm. The interviews will take place in Room 302 at the Municipal Center. Discussion continued.
