- B. T.V. – one was mounted above copier. The other will go on the living room wall.
- C. Vaccination Clinic – Last one was most successful – 45 people and 59 shots. Stop & Shop will be back on April 15. (SCHD South Central Health District)
- D. Dial-a-Ride – Driver needed. Orlando does Monday afternoons and John's hours are limited. Dave is per diem. Ed also has limited hours but driving in mornings. 18 Hour driver needed. Ad will be put out.
- E. Tax Appointments – HRA and AARP. Some appointments were canceled due to no water but rescheduled.
