IWWC PUBLIC HEARING SIGN REQUIREMENTS (if required)

If a Public Hearing is required as part of your application before the Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Commission, you must post a sign on your property to notify neighboring property owners. This sign must be displayed at least fifteen (15) days in advance of the hearing and shall remain in place until the day after the hearing.



THE SIGN MUST BE MADE OF A DURABLE MATERIAL WITH A LIGHT BLUE BACKGROUND AND BLACK BLOCK LETTERING A MINIMIUM 1-3/4" HIGH.

The sign must be erected at least two and one half (2 ½) feet but not higher than five and one half (5 ½) feet above ground. It must be set back not less than 10 feet, or more than 12 feet from the street line and the lettering must be clearly visible from the street. No sign may be allowed to obstruct motorist or pedestrian views. If your property abuts more than one street, you must post a separate sign facing each street.

You must complete the affidavit below and present it to the Commission's staff at the hearing. The affidavit must be signed by the applicant, notarized and dated same day as the hearing. The affidavit below must be signed in front of a notary public or other authorized official. The Commission will not hold a hearing if these requirements are not met.

Public Water Supply Aquifer Area Project Notification Form (if required)

All land use applications before Plainville's Planning and Zoning Commission, Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Commission, and Zoning Board of Appeals for any project located within an Aquifer Protection Area are required by State Statute to notify any locally affected water company of the proposed project by certified mail not later than 7 days after the date the application is submitted to the local jurisdiction.

The applicant must also notify the State Department of Public Health via electronic filing.
