The initial application involved a review and approval of a plan to rebuild the Town of Plainville's pump station on Shuttle Meadow Road directly adjacent to the crossing of the Quinnipiac River. The modification is within the upland review area for a temporary "lay down area" to accommodate the equipment and materials necessary for the proper staging of the project. This issue was brought up by contractors bidding on the work during pre-bid construction meetings

There is no direct impact on the wetlands. A small portion of the floodway will be temporarily impacted but will be returned to its pre-construction elevation so no deleterious long term impacts will be experienced.
