#### II. FINACIAL / BUDGET REPORT

A. 2018 – 2019 Budgets – Budget report included in packet. Directed by Town Manager to be conservative with FY 2019 Budget. I included in the packet budget summaries of our 3 Recreation Budgets. \$510,515, Berner Pool Budget line items that were approved in 2018 and requested in 2019. Full time salaries were directed to increase by 1.5%.

510 only increase in full time salary. Dir, Asst. Dir. 66%, Admin Assistant 50% for income of \$2100 only change. 515 increase 1.5% of Asst. Dir 33% of \$241.00 only other change operating supplies added \$400. Remain same Day Camp staff care program, pre/post minimum staff. Ist year in 3 years that the state did not raise minimum wage.

#### III. FACILITES REPORT

- A. <u>Berner Pool –</u> Fund balance is \$136,396. Bal in Active Budget is \$54,392.
   Did not ask for any transfer of money from fund balance. Leak repair \$12,461.00 and \$900 to evaluate situation. Recreation capital budget \$15742, money not involved in state grant and park improvement capital.
