- A. <u>Budget 2017- 2018</u> Met with Town Manager on January 26, 510 budget requested \$155,162, only increase 2% full time salaries. No changes. 515 reduction operating supplies \$800.00 same as last year (pre-post supplies day camp Berner Pool ID card save on film. Other contractual services \$3,640, Reduced by total -\$4,440 to \$258,225 from \$252,479 (increase \$5,746).
- B. <u>Picnic Fees</u> Requesting to change shelter picnic fee. Norton Activity Building, pavilion, band shell & Paderewski Park fee should raise 2017 from \$30.00 to \$50.00. 2016 \$4200, additional \$2,000.
