

TOWN OF PLAINVILLE CONSERVATION COMMISSION
Meeting held on August 12, 2015

The meeting was called to order at 7:32pm.

In attendance were Marguerite Burris, Lisa Lozier, Randall Paz, Eric Levy, Leslie Sundell, and Roberta Lauria.

Also in attendance were advisor Stephen DelBuono, Jr. and William Lauria, getting info for a report he is writing.

Dave Emery was asked to come and give an update on the improperly discarded fishing line at Paderewski and at this time Marge requested to waive the order of the agenda to let Dave get home. All were in concurrence.

Dave had gone on a website and obtained info on the containers that other areas have used for the proper disposal of fishing line and the signage that accompanies these units. Eric will get some prices for the materials that will be needed to get an idea of cost per unit. Dave doesn't have the man hours to construct these, but would be willing to purchase some or all of the materials with us or possibly even the scouts to build them. There will be a need to walk the pond to determine how many and where to be placed. Roberta also asked Dave about the area we can use in the storage shed and we were given the okay to utilize any space needed.

At this time Lisa Lozier made the motion to return to the agenda. Roberta Lauria seconded and all were in favor.

She left some extra room on the flier where it involves the MSP PTO doing the vending in case they want to list some of the items they will have available. Regarding the derby rules, she has added that all fish must be in a bucket of water or the catch doesn't count. Also

that all participants must be accompanied by an adult. She requested that the signup times be changed to Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday. As it stands, this year's signup times will be; Tues. Sept. 29th 6-8pm, Thurs. Oct.1st 6-8pm, and Sat. Oct.3rd 10-12 at the children's section of the library.

Lisa Lozier made the motion to approve the changes to the flier, registration form, and the derby rules. Eric Levy seconded and all were in favor.

SHED INVENTORY- Roberta will be planning this. No time was determined.

DEEP STOCKING- This will be put on hold.

There is a need to restock before the derby. It will be determined what can be stocked and cost factoring in the delivery charge and a tentative delivery date.


MISC ITEMS- Nothing at this time.
