

SOCIAL SECURITY

RESOLVED. That the Town of Plainville apply for membership and to participate in the Old Age and Survivor's Insurance system under Title II of the Social Security Act as amended, in accordance with Public Act No.277 of the 1951 Public Acts, as of the first day of July 1954, for all its employees with the exception of services in any class or classes of elective position, part-time position, or position the compensation for which is on a fee basis;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Board of Selectmen shall execute on behalf and in the name of the Town of Plainville any and all agreements with the State Employees' Retirement Commission for the aforesaid purpose, in accordance with and subject to the provisions of said Public Act No. 277 and subject to the regulations promulgated by the State Employees' Retirement Commission pursuant to said Public Act; and that the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Plainville, be and they are hereby authorized and directed to make, or to have made by the several pay-roll preparations units of said Town, deductions from the wages of the employees participating in the aforesaid Old-Age and Survivors Insurance System as required by Section 4 of said Public Act No.277 and to forward the amount thereof together with the contribution of the Town of Plainville to the State Employees' Retirement Commission in manner and form prescribed by the said regulations.
