

**BY-LAWS PROHIBITING THE THROWING OR PLACING OF
WASTE MATERIALS IN THE HIGHWAYS OF THE TOWN OF
PLAINVILLE, REGULATING THE DISPOSAL OF THE SAME,
AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATING THEREOF**

Be it known that on January 24, 1956 the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Plainville, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Section 625 of the General Statutes of Connecticut. Revision of 1949, approved and adopted the following by-law, effective February 20, 1956:

1. It shall be unlawful to place, throw, cause, allow or permit to be placed or thrown waste materials and paper in the highways of the Town of Plainville.
2. All such waste materials and paper when conveyed by motor vehicle, foot or any other form or kind of locomotion from one place to another on the highways of said town shall be securely fastened or covered, or otherwise maintained securely under the control of the person, firm or corporation so transporting such materials and paper so as to prevent their dispersal, or any part of them, on the public highways.
3. Violation of any provision of this by-law is hereby declared a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of ten (10) dollars for each offense.
