

# **ORDINANCE REGULATING PARADES AND OTHER FUNCTIONS UPON PUBLIC STREETS, ETC., IN THE TOWN OF PLAINVILLE**

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Plainville that:

**SECTION 1. REQUEST FOR PERMISSION.** Any person, group or organization desiring to use the public streets or town property in the Town of Plainville for a parade or for any other reason, including the use of loud-speakers, shall request permission in writing of the Director of Safety or his designated agent.

**SEC. 2. GRANT OF PERMISSION.** The Director of Safety, or his designated agent, shall satisfy himself as to the safety and welfare of the general public before such permission is granted in writing taking into consideration (1) routing of traffic, (2) routing for emergency vehicles, (3) adequate detours, (4) adequate police protection and (5) date and time in question.

**SEC. 3. APPLICABILITY.** The provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to any Town property under the jurisdiction of any department or commission having its own regulations regarding these matters.

**SEC. 4. ENFORCEMENT.** Any person, group or organization violating any provisions of this ordinance shall be fined no more than \$25.00 for each violation.

**SEC. 5. INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES REPEALED.** All ordinances in existence and inconsistent with this ordinance on the effective date of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
