

ORDINANCE REGARDING TOWN OF PLAINVILLE

PARTICIPATION IN REGIONAL PLANNING

SECTION 1. ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of Public Act 613 of the 1959 Session of the General Assembly, the Town of Plainville hereby adopts Public Act 613 of the General Statutes and joins in the creation of the regional planning agency for the New Britain-Bristol region as defined by the Connecticut Development Commission under the provisions of Public Act 448 of the 1959 Session of the General Assembly.

SEC. 2. LOCAL REPRESENTATION, APPOINTMENTS AND TERMS. The Town of Plainville, having a population of 13,063 according to the federal census of 1960 shall have two (2) representatives on the agency, who shall not be of the same political party and who shall be appointed as follows:

- (a) Pursuant to Section 2 of Public Act 613 of the 1959 Session of the General Assembly, the Town Planning and Zoning Commission duly constituted by the Town Charter, is hereby authorized to appoint to the regional planning agency one (1) elector of the Town of Plainville for an initial term of two (2) years.
- (b) The Town Council is hereby authorized to appoint to the agency one (1) elector of the Town of Plainville for an initial term of one (1) year.

All appointments thereafter shall be made for a period of two (2) years. All appointees shall continue to serve after expiration of their terms until their successors are appointed and take office. Appointees may be reappointed for successive terms, and must during their entire term in office remain electors of the Town of Plainville. Terms of office of initial appointees shall commence on November 1, 1960, regardless of whether or not said regional planning agency has been established by said date.

SEC. 3. VACANCIES. Upon any member vacancy being created, the appointing authority responsible for the appointment shall appoint another elector of the Town of Plainville to fill the unexpired term, which replacement appointee shall continue to serve after the expiration of his term until a successor is appointed and takes office. Replacement appointees may be reappointed for successive terms.

SEC. 4. RESIGNATION OF MEMBER. Any representative who is absent from three (3) consecutive regular or/and special meetings of the regional planning agency shall be considered to have resigned from said regional planning agency and the vacancy shall be filled in accordance with Section 3 herein. The requirements of this section may be waived by the appointing authority where illness or other extenuating circumstances makes it impossible for a representative to meet the attendance requirements of this section.

SEC. 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective on October 1, 1960.
