

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CLERICAL AND LEGAL ASSISTANTS OF THE TOWN COUNSEL

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Plainville in meeting duly assembled, pursuant to Chapter V Section 4 of the Charter of the Town of Plainville:

1. The Town Counsel shall have the right to engage all clerical assistance he deems necessary for the proper performance of his office at his discretion without the necessity of a vote by the Town Council of the Town of Plainville.
2. The Town Counsel, if and when he deems necessary, shall have the right to engage legal assistants in the performance of his duties after first securing the approval of the Town Council of the Town of Plainville. The Town Council of the Town of Plainville must vote such approval, but such vote need not be in the form of an ordinance or resolution nor require a public hearing.
3. All clerical and legal assistants engaged in the past and presently engaged are hereby ratified and affirmed by the Town Council upon the passage and publication of this ordinance.
