

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE LICENSING OF
SIDEWALK INSTALLERS IN THE TOWN OF PLAINVILLE**

SECTION 1.0. LICENSES. Every person, firm or corporation engaged in, or having direct charge of the installation of sidewalks in existing or proposed rights of way in the Town of Plainville shall be licensed in accordance with the following:

SEC. 1.1. CLASSIFICATION OF LICENSE. License shall cover the scope outlined in Section 1.0 only.

SEC. 1.2. APPLICATION FOR LICENSE. Every person, firm or corporation desiring to be licensed under Section 1.1 shall file with the Building Department an application in such form as prescribed by the Department. Said applications must be completely filled in, signed with legal signature of the person, president or owner of the firm or corporation desiring to be licensed and shall be notarized. Upon receipt of the application properly executed, the Building Official, or his designated agent, shall review the application and if all requirements are met by the applicant, shall issue a license within seven (7) days of receipt of application.

SEC. 1.3. REGISTRATION OF LICENSE. Upon issuance of any license, the name, business address and number of said license shall be entered on a record kept for that purpose and said record shall be open to public inspection.

SEC. 1.4. TERM OF LICENSE. All licenses shall expire on June 30 of each year, but may be renewed within a grace period of thirty days for one year upon payment of the required renewal fee. Licenses not renewed as required above shall become null and void and may be renewed only upon payment of the fee prescribed for initial licenses.

SEC. 1.5. FEES.

Initial license \$25.00

Renewal license \$10.00

SEC. 1.6. PERMITS. The fee for new sidewalk or curb installation shall be \$3.00 per 100 lineal feet or any part thereof. No permit fee shall be required for repair or replacement of broken

or damaged walks except that a permit application shall be properly executed and placed on file with the Building Department before start of repair or replacement.

SEC. 1.7. PERFORMANCE BOND. Before any person, firm or corporation is issued a license, a performance bond in the amount of \$2,000, naming the Town of Plainville as obligee, shall be placed on file in the office of the Building Inspector.

SEC. 1.8. UNLAWFUL USE OF LICENSE. No person having procured a license as a sidewalk installer shall permit or allow the use of his name by any other person, directly or indirectly, for the purpose of obtaining a permit to do any installation of sidewalks as noted in Section 1.0.
