

## **ORDINANCE REGARDING THE LICENSING OF CERTAIN ENTERTAINMENT SHOWS**

**SECTION 1. PERMIT REQUIRED.** No person, association, organization or corporation shall conduct any circus, carnival or tent show in the Town of Plainville without first obtaining a permit therefor from the Town Council of the Town of Plainville or its designated agent.

**SEC. 2. APPLICATION.** An applicant for a permit hereunder must file with the Director of Safety the following information and material:

A. A written application, on a prepared form, providing the following data:

- (1.) Name and business address of firm originating entertainment.
- (2.) Name of principal or manager who will supervise while operating in Plainville.
- (3.) Name of local person, firm, association or organization sponsoring entertainment, if any.
- (4.) Name and residence address of principal, or senior officer, of such sponsor.
- (5.) Inclusive dates for which permit is requested.
- (6.) Location at which entertainment will be conducted.
- (7.) Category of entertainment.

B. A certificate of insurance, providing bodily injury and property damage coverage of not less than \$100,000.00 per person, and not less than \$300,000.00 per occurrence. Said application and certificate shall be provided at least fifteen days prior to date on which entertainment will commence.

**SEC. 3. REVOCATION.** Said permit may be revoked at any time by the Director of Safety if it is determined that such entertainment fails to comply with the requirements of the Connecticut State Fire Marshal, the Plainville Fire Marshal, the Plainville Director of Health, or if such entertainment is conducted in an unlawful manner or in such a manner as to constitute a

menace to the health, safety or general welfare of the public. Said permit may also be revoked for fraud, misrepresentation or false statement in the application therefor.

**SEC. 4. ENFORCEMENT.** Violation of any provision of this ordinance shall result in a fine of fifty (\$50.00) dollars for each such violation.
