

# **ORDINANCE REGULATING RECREATIONAL VEHICLES OR OTHER VEHICLES IN THE TOWN OF PLAINVILLE**

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Town Council of the Town of Plainville, in meeting duly assembled:

## **SECTION 1. DEFINITION.**

(a) "Recreational Vehicle" shall mean motor bikes, mopeds, dirt bikes, snowmobiles, mini-bikes, all-terrain vehicles or any other motorized recreational vehicle.

(b) "Motor Vehicle" shall mean that type of vehicle as defined by Section 14-1 (47) of the Connecticut General Statutes.

(c) "Motorcycle" shall mean that type of vehicle as defined by Section 14-1 (46) of the Connecticut General Statutes.

(d) "Town Land" shall mean any land owned or leased by the Town, including but not limited to parks, school sites, easements, and any other properties wherein the Town has any rights to the usage of the same.

## **SECTION 2. VIOLATION.**

No Owner or Operator of a Recreational Vehicle shall operate or shall allow the operation of said vehicle on Town Land.

## **SECTION 3.**

A Motor Vehicle or Motorcycle shall only be operated on Town Land designated roadways or parking areas, unless the owner/operator has received written permission from the Director of Safety exempting said vehicle from this Ordinance.

## **SECTION 4. PENALTY.**

Any violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of \$99.00.

**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after the publication of the same.
