
Borrowing E-BOOKS with Your KINDLE or Kindle Compatible Device

You Will Need:


1. Your Kindle (or iPad/other compatible device with an installed Kindle App).
2. Your Amazon account username and password.
3. Your Plainville Library Card number.

To Download An E-Book:


1. Log into your Amazon account at www.amazon.com and leave the page open.
2. Open a separate window and go to our website www.plainvillelibrary.org
3. On the Home Page click on “Downloadable Audio and E-Books”




4. From the dropdown menu, select Plainville Public Library. Click “GO”
5. Enter your Plainville Library card number and click on the “Sign In” tab. If you are working from a home computer, you may choose to check the box next to “Remember my login information on this device.” Once this option is checked the computer will conveniently remember your library card number for future sessions. Only choose this option if you are working from a secure, personal home device.
6. Once signed in, you may browse our collection of downloadable books by genre using the category selections at the top of the page. You may also browse by book cover or you may search for a specific title using the Search bar on the right side of the top of the page.
 - Since the Library offers E-Books in different formats, you may wish to start off by limiting the titles you view to display only Kindle Books. To do this, simply click on the “Advanced Search” option underneath the Search bar.



- Locate the “All Formats” dropdown menu and select “Kindle Book” from the list of options.
- By checking the box “Available Now” at the bottom of the page you will automatically limit your search to books available for immediate download.
- Once you have selected your preferences, click “Search.”




7. When you have found an item you wish to download, select the title and click on the “Borrow” button. If all copies of the book are currently checked out, you will see the “Place a Hold” button instead. By clicking on the “Place a Hold” button, you will be placed on the hold list for the item. When the E-Book is available for download you will be notified by email.



- Book covers that display a  symbol mean that the Plainville Library has purchased additional copies of the title for Plainville patron use. The wait time for Plainville patrons with holds on these titles will be shorter because more copies are in circulation.

8. After clicking on the “Borrow” button, your virtual Bookshelf opens. To download your E-Book, click on the “Download” button and select “Kindle Book.” Click on “Confirm and Download.”



9. An Amazon window is automatically opened. Click on the yellow “Get Library Book” button on the right side of the window.

The book will automatically download to your Kindle or Kindle App wirelessly the next time your device is connected to Wi-Fi


or

the book may be downloaded by connecting the Kindle to your computer with the USB cable and then clicking “Download Now” option in Amazon.



10. Congratulations! You have finished the downloading process. Your E-Book loan lasts for three weeks. Once the lending period is over the title is automatically returned, so you will never have to worry about fines. You may check out up to four E-Books at a time. You can manage your Bookshelf, Holds, Wish List, and Settings all through the “Account” button located at the top right of your screen.

- To return your E-Book early, log into your Amazon account and click on “Manage Your Content and Devices” in the menu under “Your Account”



- Find the title you wish to return and click the “Actions” button and click “Return this book”



Click on “Search The Library Catalog.” Search for an author or title and limit your search by Format (E-book or Downloadable Audiobook) in the column on the left. Find your desired title. Click on “check availability.” If any patron can access the title via OverDrive click on the link “All patrons click here to access this title from OverDrive.”

If the Plainville Library has purchased extra copies for its patrons click on the link specific to Plainville patrons.
