

## CERTIFICATE OF TRADE NAME

**Note: a trade name certificate is required by Section 35-1 of the Connecticut General Statutes for the purpose of identifying those individuals doing business in the state under a fictitious trade name, i.e. for consumer protection purposes. A trade name certificate does not protect that name from use by someone else.**

**The penalty for failure to file a trade name certificate is \$500.00**
