2. Consider recommendation of the Aviation Commission to engage Loureiro Engineering Associates, Inc. to perform Construction Administration Services for the Apron Rehabilitation Project at Robertson Airport.

Councilwoman Tompkins motioned to authorize Robert E. Lee, Town Manager to execute an Agreement with Loureiro Engineering Associates, Inc. of Plainville, CT to provide Construction Administration Services for the Apron Rehabilitation Project at Robertson Field in an amount of \$91,500 as recommended by the Aviation Commission. The motion was seconded by Councilman Cox and passed 6-0.
