

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING AN ADDITIONAL AMOUNT OF EXEMPTION FROM PROPERTY TAX FOR PERSONS WHO ARE BLIND

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Plainville in meeting duly assembled that pursuant to the Charter of the Town of Plainville the following amendments to the Ordinance entitled An Ordinance Regarding Amendment to an Ordinance Regarding an Additional Amount of Exemption From Property Tax for Persons Who are Blind are adopted:

SECTION 1. In accordance with the provisions of Sec. 12-81j of the General Statutes, as amended, any person entitled to the exemption from property tax applicable to the assessed value of property up to the amount of Three Thousand and 00/100 (\$3,000.00) Dollars, as provided under subdivision (17) of Section 12-81 of the General Statutes, shall be entitled to an additional exemption from such tax in an amount up to Two Thousand and 00/100 (\$2,000.00) Dollars of such assessed value, provided such person qualifies under the provisions of said Sec.12-81j.

SECTION 2. Any person submitting a claim for the additional exemption as provided in said Sec. 12-81j shall file an application, on a form prepared for such purpose by the Assessor, not later than the date of the assessment list with respect to which such additional exemption is claimed. Each such application shall include such documentation as required by said Sec. 12-81j and such evidence as may be required by the Assessor relating to income.

SECTION 3. The levels of qualifying income for the tax credits under this Ordinance shall be those set out in Sec. 12-81l and Sec. 12-170aa of the General Statutes, adjusted annually as provided for in said General Statutes.

SECTION 4. This amendment shall take effect after passage and publication.
