- COVID: COVID testing was done outdoors from August February by Community Health

 clinics. Masks still required indoors.

- 6. FY22 Budget has been approved. Stove & dishwasher bought by Town Council. New floor tile in bathroom and nurse's room. \$2,500 received from Bishop's Relief Fund for Dial-a-Ride.
- 7. Staff Changes Evelyn Morin retired after 22 years. Morgan Poeta hired, MS in counseling, will be here part time Monday-Thursday, 2 p.m. closing. Will coordinate Circle Group volunteers and Memory Café, Jeannette Brodeur PT Office Assistant.
