

Borrowing E-BOOKS With Your NOOK or Other EPUB Reader


You Will Need:

1. Your Nook, the Nook USB cable and the computer you plan to use to download E-Books from our catalog.
2. Your library card number.
3. Adobe Digital Editions downloaded on to your computer. To download this free software go to <http://www.adobe.com/products/digital-editions.html> Click on “Download” and follow the steps to complete the download. Adobe Digital Editions only needs to be downloaded once. You may need to create a free Adobe account before you can open and use Adobe Digital Editions.



To Download An E-Book:

1. Go to our website, www.plainvillelibrary.org
2. On the Home Page click on “E-Books & More”



3. Click on the “Download Overdrive” icon at the top of the page




4. From the dropdown menu, select Plainville Public Library. (If you have a card from a library other than Plainville, select that town from the dropdown menu.)



5. Enter your library card number and click “Sign In.”
 - a. If you are working from a personal device, you may choose to check the box next to “Remember my card number on this device.” Once this option is checked the device will conveniently remember your library card number for future sessions. Only choose this option if you are working from a secure, personal home device.
6. Once signed in, you may browse our collection of downloadable books by genre, book cover or use the search bar on the top right side of the page for a specific search.

- a. Since the library offers E-books in many different formats, you may wish to start your search by limiting the results to only books compatible with the Nook. To do so click on the “magnifying glass” icon on the Search bar.



This will expand the menu and give the option to do an “Advanced Search.”




- b. Locate the “All Formats” dropdown menu and select “EPUB eBook” from the list.
- c. You may choose to limit your search to the titles that are currently available. Locate the “Availability” dropdown menu and select “Available Now” - you will automatically limit your search to books available for immediate download.
- d. Once you have selected your preferences click “Search”


7. When you have found an item you wish to download, hover over the title and click on the word "Borrow."



(If all copies of the book are currently checked out, you will see the words "Place a Hold" instead of "Borrow." By clicking on the "Place a Hold" option, you will be placed on the hold list for the item. When the E-book is available for download you will be notified by email.)

8. Once you click on the word "Borrow," a message will appear letting you know when the ebook is due. To complete the download, click on the word "Loans."









- a. Click the "Choose a Format" drop-down menu
 - b. Choose "EPUB eBook"
9. The book will automatically download and should open in Adobe Digital Editions.
 10. To read the book on your Nook, connect the Nook to your computer via the USB cable. From here you can drag and drop the title from Adobe Digital Editions onto the Nook icon located on your screen (make sure when dragging the title to the Nook icon that you do not release the mouse until the Nook icon is highlighted). The E-Book will immediately download to your Nook.
 11. Congratulations! You have finished the downloading process. Your E-Book loan lasts for three weeks. Once the lending period is over the title is automatically returned, so you will never have to worry about fines. You may check out up to four E-Books at a time. You can manage your Bookshelf, Holds, Wish List, and Settings all through the "Account" button located at the top right of your screen.
 - To return your E-Book early, just click the arrow in the left corner of the book cover in Adobe Digital Editions (or right click for the menu) and choose "Return Borrowed Item." This is only necessary if you wish to check out another book, but have already reached the maximum number of E-Books allowed to be checked out at once.



You may also access E-Books and Downloadable Audiobooks through the Plainville Library Catalog. Go to the Library's website. Click on "Search The Library Catalog." Search for an author or title and limit your search by Format (E-book or Downloadable Audiobook) in the column on the left. Find your desired title. Click on "check availability." If any patron can access the title via OverDrive click on the link "All patrons click here to access this title from OverDrive." If the Plainville Library has purchased extra copies for its patrons click the link specific to Plainville patrons.
