

**LEGAL NOTICE
TOWN OF PLAINVILLE
REFERENDUM OF ELECTORS
JANUARY 30, 2018**

In accordance with the Charter of the Town of Plainville and the General Statutes of the State of Connecticut, a referendum of qualified electors of the Town of Plainville will be held on Tuesday, January 30, 2018, between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. to vote for approval or disapproval of an ordinance adopted by the Town Council on December 4, 2017, entitled “Ordinance Appropriating \$15,761,000 For Upgrades and Related Improvements to the Town’s Water Pollution Control Facility, And Authorizing The Issue Of Bonds And Notes To Finance The Portion Of The Appropriation Not Defrayed From Grants”. The full text of the ordinance is on file and available for public inspection during normal business hours in the office of the Town Clerk in the Plainville Municipal Center, One Central Square in Plainville and at the Plainville Public Library, 56 East Main Street in Plainville. The ordinance will be placed on the ballots under the following heading:

“SHALL THE TOWN OF PLAINVILLE APPROPRIATE \$15,761,000 FOR UPGRADES AND RELATED IMPROVEMENTS TO THE TOWN’S WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FACILITY, AND AUTHORIZE THE ISSUE OF BONDS AND NOTES TO FINANCE THE PORTION OF THE APPROPRIATION NOT DEFRAID FROM GRANTS?”

Electors approving the ordinance will vote “Yes” and those opposing the ordinance will vote “No”.

Voting will be at the following polling place: Plainville Fire House, 77 West Main Street in Plainville.

Absentee ballots may be obtained from the office of the Town Clerk, and will be available starting January 8, 2018. Absentee ballots will be counted at the Plainville Fire House, 77 West Main Street in Plainville.
