





When is the election? What is on the ballot?

- The 2023 Municipal Elections will be on Tuesday, November 7, 2023. Polls will be open from 6:00 AM - 8:00 PM.
- The ballot will include offices up for election, such as Town Council, Board of Education, Constables, and Library Trustees. The ballot will also feature four questions on proposed revisions to the Town Charter.



When is the last day to register to vote to be eligible to vote this year?

The last day to register to vote in-person, online, and by mail is Tuesday, October 31, 2023.

- The Registrars of Voters Office/Elections Department located on the Middle-Level of the Municipal Center will be open from 9:00 AM – 8:00 PM on October 31, 2023 for in-person voter registration.
- Online voter registration is available until 11:59 PM on October 31, 2023.
- Mail-in registrations must be postmarked October 31, 2023.

Election Day Registration is facilitated by the Registrar of Voters Office/Elections Department. Those interested in registering to vote on Election Day must do so in the Registrars of Voters Office/Elections Department at the Municipal Center.



Am I eligible to request an absentee ballot?

If a registered voter is unable to vote in person on Election Day, they may apply to the Town Clerk for an absentee ballot for any of the following reasons:

Active Service in the U.S. Armed Forces	Physical Disability
Your religion forbids secular (non- religious) activity on that day	Your required performance of duties at a polling place other than your own
Sickness	Absence from Town

Before a ballot can be issued, an application must be completed and returned. The application can be obtained in-person, by mail, or online. Once completed, the application must be mailed to the Town Clerk's Office, dropped off in the secure, video monitored Drop Box, or hand delivered to the Town Clerk's Office.

When and where do I submit my absentee ballot?

IN PERSON

Voters can submit ballots in-person at the Town Clerk's Office no later than 5:00 PM on Monday, November 6, 2023.

MAIL

Voters can mail their ballot to the Town Clerk's Office. Ballots must be received (not postmarked) no later than Tuesday, November 7, 2023 at 8:00 PM.

DROP BOX Voters can drop off their ballots, at any time, in the Official Ballot Drop Box outside the side entrance of the Municipal Center no later than Tuesday, November 7, 2023 at 8:00 PM.
