COVID-19 Vaccinations Available for those 75 years of age and older *PSHD Encourages Eligible Residents to Get Vaccinated*

The Plainville Southington Health District (PSHD) encourages all eligible residents to get vaccinated for COVID-19. Those 75 years of age and older, healthcare professionals, long term care facility residents, and medical first responders are all qualified at this time.

"Due to limited vaccine supply, Connecticut has prioritized vaccination tier groups in an effort to get those high-risk groups vaccinated," said Shane Lockwood, PSHD Director of Health. "As the state continues to open more tier groups, more vaccination sites are being stood up."

There are several ways to register for vaccination.

- Visit https://dphsubmissions.ct.gov/OnlineVaccine to create a VAMS account. Once account is activated, you can search available locations and times for vaccination appointments.
- Call 2-1-1 for assistance in scheduling an appointment and finding a vaccination site near you.
- Visit Hartford Healthcare at https://hartfordhealthcare.org/health-wellness/covidvaccine/schedule-your-vaccineinto and access your Hartford Healthcare MyChartPlus account. If you don't have an account, you can simply create one.
