PLAINVILLE TOWN COUNCIL MUNICIPAL CENTER, ONE CENTRAL SQUARE BUDGET SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES MARCH 11, 2021

The Plainville Town Council held a Special Meeting on Thursday March 11, 2021 in the Municipal Center, One Central Square for the purpose of considering and acting upon the FY 2022 budget as proposed by the Town Manager. Chairwoman Pugliese called the Special Meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Present were Vice Chairwoman Tompkins, Town Council members Wazorko, Morante, Gnazzo, Rocco, Underwood, Town Manager Lee, Assistant Town Manager Daskal, Finance Director Buden and Town Clerk Porrini.

The following actions were taken and compared to the current year's budget.

<u>170-Economic Development Agency</u> – Vice Chairwoman Tompkins motioned to approve Department 170-Economic Development Agency for \$70,800 reflecting an increase of \$10,225. The motion was seconded by Councilman Underwood and passed 7-0.

<u>101-Town Council</u> - Vice Chairwoman Tompkins motioned to approve Department 101-Town Council for \$74,309 reflecting an increase of \$2000. The motion was seconded by Councilman Gnazzo and passed 7-0.

<u>131-Town Manager</u> - Vice Chairwoman Tompkins motioned to approve Department 131-Town Manager for \$344,398 reflecting an increase of \$57,666. The motion was seconded by Councilman Underwood and passed 7-0.

<u>132-Human Resources</u> - Vice Chairwoman Tompkins motioned to approve Department 132-Human Resources for \$128,185 reflecting an increase of \$25,262. The motion was seconded by Councilman Gnazzo and passed 7-0.

<u>910-Board of Education</u> – Councilman Wazorko motioned to approve the Board of Education's expenditure budget for \$39,826,972, reflecting an increase of \$682,705. The motion was seconded by Vice Chairwoman Tompkins and passed 7-0.

A motion was made at 7:13 p.m. to adjourn and passed unanimously.
